HISTORIC ELEGANCE IN THE HEART OF EDGBASTON

For more than **300** years, the Plough & Harrow has welcomed travellers to Birmingham.

First established in **1704** as a rural coaching inn with stables for visitors arriving on the road into the city, it quickly became renowned for its hospitality and warm welcome.

The original inn was rebuilt between **1832 and 1833** by the Calthorpe Estate, creating the distinctive Victorian red-brick building that still stands today. Over the generations, the hotel has welcomed countless guests, from business travellers and families to notable figures including **J.R.R. Tolkien**, who spent the night of his wedding here in **1916**. Its rich heritage and striking architecture have earned the Plough & Harrow its place as one of Birmingham's best-known historic hotels.

Throughout the 1950s, 60s, 70s and 80s, the hotel was regarded as one of the finest in the region. Following a period of decline, it returned to private ownership in the 2010s, and an gradual and ongoing programme of investment is carefully restoring its warmth, character and reputation while preserving the individuality that has made it so special for generations.

Today, nestled in the leafy surroundings of Edgbaston and just a short walk from the cafés, restaurants and boutiques of Edgbaston Village, the Plough & Harrow offers a unique blend of historic charm and contemporary comfort. Whether you're joining us for coffee, drinks on the terrace, dinner with friends, a business meeting, wedding celebration or an overnight stay, you'll always receive the warm, personal hospitality that has been at the heart of the hotel for more than three centuries.
