- Orders can be placed at the bar but "propping up the bar" is no longer allowed (sitting is more comfortable anyway).
- We are asking customers to take a table slightly larger than they may usually need so we can serve your meal directly to you whilst still maintaining a safe distance.
- Hand sanitiser stations at all doors and throughout the building
- Your details will be taken on booking or arrival to comply with the government "Track & Trace" scheme. These will be destroyed after 21 days and will not be passed on or used for any kind of marketing.

## **Accommodation Guests:**

- Check-in and check-out processes have been streamlined to shorten face to face time in reception.
- Hand sanitiser at all entrances and throughout the building.
- Certain items have been removed from bedrooms but are available on request.
- Breakfast orders must be handed in night prior to reception (currently from a shortened menu).
