# WHITE WINE

- Stringy Bark Creek Chardonnay**, South East Australia  
A delicious Chardonnay with notes of melon and zesty freshness on the finish. (2) Vegetarian

- Voyage Des Animaux Sauvignon Blanc**, Côtes de Gascogne, South of France  
Hints of bright lemon-green with refreshing citrus fruit and subtle floral aromas. Very zesty, with green apple and gooseberry flavours. The palate is all about minerality with a smooth finish. (2)

- Frunza Pinot Grigio**, Banat, Romania

# RED WINE

- Stringy Bark Creek Shiraz**, South East Australia  
Cool intensity is the style here, showing dark, fresh flavours. (C)

- Patriarche Merlot**, Languedoc-Roussillon, South of France  
Initial aromas of black fruits are followed by spicy notes. The palate is silky and well-rounded with good tannins and a long length. (C)

- Ermita de San Felices Crianza**, Rioja, Spain  
Very smart, modern Rioja, with smoky, spicy fruit and enveloped by a neatly integrated silky oak overcoat. Fine concentration and power - a real over-performer in its class. (C)

- Tamari Malbec**, Mendoza, Argentina  
Soft red fruit notes with elegantly smooth tannins and a lingering finish. A great example of Argentina's hallmark red wine. (C)
