In the event of an emergency – such as fire – a continuous siren will sound.

Please leave the building by the nearest available exit.

Should you require assistance in evacuating please advise reception to complete a PEEP form on arrival.

## Reception

The phones in your bedroom are house phones only - you cannot dial outside the hotel.

To contact reception - dial 0 from the house phone - or 01383 722282 from a mobile.

In the event of an emergency dial 999 from your own device.

If you become unwell during your stay you may contact NHS 24 on 111 from your own device. (only British Phones). Alternatively contact reception, the duty managers are all qualified first aiders, the hotel is equipped with a defibrillator.

Full reception services are only available from 07:30 – 23:30.

Should you be departing prior to 07:30, please settle your account the night prior.

The night porter is on duty 23:30 – 07:30.

## Express Check Out

No Need to Queue to Check Out - Express Check out is available 07:30-23:30

We can email a copy of your invoice with a secure payment link to settle your account.

We accept credit and debit cards, American Express, Visa and Master Card

## Smoking

Smoking is NOT permitted within the hotel, this includes the use of electronic cigarettes.

However there are three outside “smoking areas” with cigarette bins. Should we find a guest has been smoking in a bedroom, there is a deep cleaning charge of £150.00.

Valuables may be deposited for safe keeping in the hotel safe. This facility is open from 7:30 am - 23:30 and is free of charge. Your attention is drawn to the hotel Proprietors Act notice displayed at reception.

Room Service is available 24/7, please place your order either at reception or by dialing "0".

There are Tea and Coffee making facilities in your bedroom. - Complimentary supplies are available at reception.

## Laundry

Should you wish to use the laundry service, please complete the laundry list provided and place in the Laundry Bag (which can be found in your top drawer) and return to reception. Same Day Service is not always available, check with the desk.

## Additional Amenities

For extra towels or pillows, please contact Reception. Housekeeping will deliver these items to your room at no additional charge. This service is available 24 hours a day.

Extra blankets can be found in your wardrobe.

All electrical sockets in the hotel are 3 pin 240 volt 50hz.

Electrical adapters are available from Reception, free of charge, on a loan basis.

Also available at reception - Toothbrush Kit, Shaving Kit, Shower Cap, Combs, Wash Cloth and Sanitary Items.

## Water

The water from the cold tap is 100% safe to drink; bottled water is available to purchase in our bars.

## Heating

Each bedroom has a thermostatically controlled radiator, which can be adjusted to suit individual preferences. In the middle of the night and in early afternoon the heating will be switched to standby in line with the hotels environmental policy.

Electric fans are available from reception at no extra charge.

## Housekeeping

Housekeeping is available daily. However we do not automatically service your room on multiple night stays, to ensure your room is serviced as required please hang the blue "Room Ready for Service" sign on the outside of your bedroom door.

We would ask you to support our Environmental Policy by requesting your room NOT to be serviced. By NOT having your room serviced we will be able to reduce chemicals going into the environment and reduce water usage. To help support this initiative please place green door hanger on the outside of the door " Please Don't Service my Room."
